Dear Mr. Jost:

This is in response to your FOIA appeal of May 24, 1990, which was received by the Legal Services Corporation ("LSC" or "Corporation") on that date. Your appeal relates to the May 23, 1990, partial denial of access by the FOIA office of the Corporation to the employment contracts of Terrance J. Wear and James Wootton.

In light of the provisions of 5 U.S.C. §552 and 45 C.F.R. Part 1602, and after review of the facts, I have determined that the redacted portions of those contracts will not be released to you, since the information contained therein is personal and confidential, the release of which would be a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

You have the right to seek judicial review of this decision by filing a complaint in the Federal court in the district where you reside, in the district where you have your principal place of business, or in the District of Columbia. See 5 U.S.C. §552(a)(4).
